How to Properly Paint a Fiberglass Egg?

To achieve a **durable and aesthetic** finish, follow these key steps:

- **First, thoroughly clean the surface** of the egg to remove dust, ensuring better paint adhesion.
- Next, **choose the right paint** – preferably **acrylic exterior paint** that is resistant to UV rays, moisture, and temperature changes.
- Select **painting tools**, such as a brush, roller, or sprayer, depending on the size of the egg and the desired effect.
- **Apply the paint evenly in thin layers**, allowing it to dry according to the manufacturer's recommendations (usually a few hours). Painting should be done in a **well-ventilated area**, at an **optimal temperature of 10°C – 30°C**, avoiding rain and high humidity.
- Once fully dry, **protect the surface with a clear varnish** (preferably a protective coating), applying two layers with sufficient drying time between them.
- Finally, allow the egg to **fully cure**, following the varnish manufacturer's instructions, so you can enjoy a **long-lasting and stunning decoration!**









What is an Open-Air Gallery?

It is a unique form of art exhibition in public spaces. In many cities in Poland and abroad, **“open-air galleries”** have emerged, where artistically decorated fiberglass eggs become part of the urban landscape. This is an excellent way to promote local culture and the creativity of residents – from young children to adults. The eggs, placed in squares, parks, and pedestrian areas, encourage people to take walks and admire the collective artwork.
